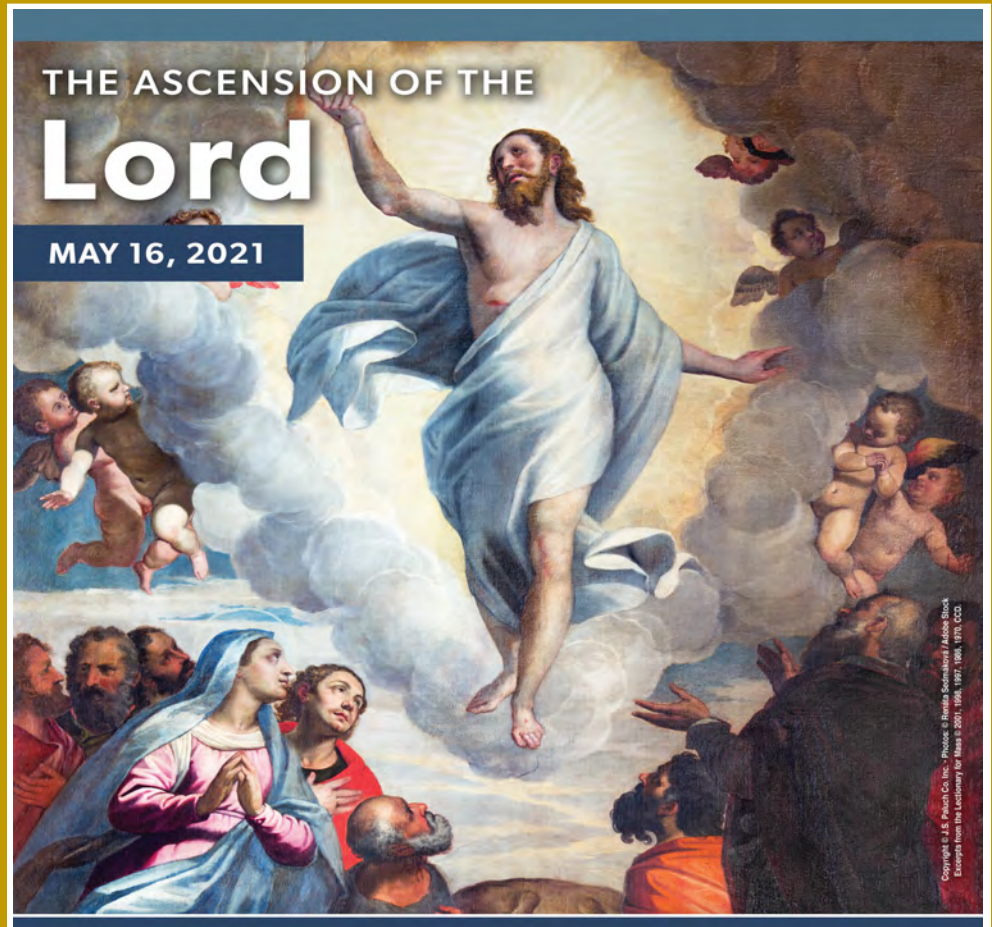

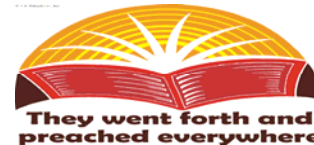

Fr. Juan's Flintstone

My best wishes to everyone. My flintstone is back. As you know, the month of May is traditionally dedicated to the Blessed Virgin Mary. Some Catholics designate a place of honor in their homes for a statue/picture of the Mother of our Redeemer. There one (yourself and your family) can pray for her maternal intercession to her Son for your intentions, those of our parish, of the Church and of the world. In addition to the remembrance of Mary of Nazareth, this special Year, we contemplate Blessed Joseph, her spouse. Pope Francis has also invited all Catholics to pray the holy rosary daily for all those throughout the world who are being affected by the pandemic. Mary and Joseph would ask the Lord for a good health of all peoples, as we do it.

Some of our Catholic people are worried after having been following the news coming from German Church, ME TOO, about a new schism or division. The Germanic Bishops propose:

- to bless every pair of persons without distinction in how they live (you name all the varieties).
- to give the Holy Communion to whomever without distinction how they live, just if they believe it.
- women to be ordered deaconesses, priestesses, bishops, cardinals, and pope.
- and why not the celibacy for priests.

+THEY DO NOT REALIZE THESE PROPOSES ARE MADE IN THE PROTESTANT CHURCHES AND THEY SUFFER THE SAME EMPTINESS.

In June 2020, Pope Francis wrote a letter-published in the media- to the German faithful, in which he said "share the **concern about the future of the Church in Germany**" and noted "**the erosion of faith**", process that **ends up distancing**. Nevertheless, Rome (Holy See and her theologians) must deal seriously with German Bishops' extravagances. No many months before the pandemic, the Anglican Church began to offer Circus and performances during the Sunday Masses inside the temples to gain attendees, specially parents with kids.

Dear brethren, let us beg to the Holy Spirit, through Mary and Joseph, to remain all of us truly faithful to Jesus' words we heard last Sunday: Jn. 15: 10 *If you keep my commandments, you will remain in my love, just as I have kept my Father's commandments and remain in his love.*

El Pedernal del P. Juan

Mis mejores deseos para todos. El pedernal vuelve. Como bien saben, el mes de mayo tradicionalmente *mes de las flores* se dedica a la Virgen María. Algunos católicos dedican un lugar en la casa colocando una imagen o cuadro de la Madre de nuestro Redentor. Y ahí, rezan cada uno o juntos en familia rogando su maternal intercesión a su Hijo por las intenciones personales, de la parroquia, de la iglesia y del mundo. Además del recuerdo a María de Nazareth, este año en especial, contemplamos a san José, su esposo. El Papa Francisco ha invitado a los católicos al rezo diario del rosario por todos los que a lo largo del mundo padecemos la pandemia. María y José pedirían igualmente al Señor una buena salud para todos los pueblos, como ahora hacemos nosotros.

Algunos de católicos están preocupadísimos (Y YO) tras oír las noticias que llegan de la iglesia alemana. Un nuevo cisma o división se está formando. Los obispos germanos proponen:

- bendecir a cualquier pareja de personas sin distinción de cómo vivan (enumere variedades).
- dar la Sda. Comunión a cualquiera sin distinción de cómo viva, basta que lo crean.
- que las mujeres sean ordenadas diaconisas, sacerdotisas, obispos, cardenales y papa.
- y cómo no, el celibato para sacerdotes.

+ NO SE DAN CUENTA DE QUE ESAS PROPUESTAS YA ESTÁN HECHAS EN LAS IGLESIAS PROTESTANTES Y ELLAS SUFREN EL MISMO VACÍO DE FIELES.

En Junio'20, el Papa Francisco escribió una carta, pública en los medios, a los files alemanes, en la que decía "compartir la **preocupación sobre el futuro de la Iglesia en Alemania**" y que "la **erosión de la fe**" es el proceso que termina en el distanciamiento. Aun así, es Roma (Santa Sede y sus teólogos) quien debe tratar seriamente con los obispos alemanes y sus extravagancias. La Iglesia Anglicana empezó antes de la pandemia a ofrecer espectáculos de circo y otras actuaciones en las Misas Dominicales para atraer asistentes, especialmente padres con hijos.

Queridos hermanos, roguemos al Espíritu Santo, por María y José, que permanezcamos cómo Jesús lo proclamó el domingo: Jn. 15, 10 *Si cumplen mis mandatos, permanecen en mi amor; lo mismo que yo cumplo los mandatos de mi Padre y permanezco en su amor.*
