## HISTORY OF SALVATION

The first reading today continues the “history of salvation” narrative that we hear throughout Lent this year. Today’s story was among the best-loved in the Jewish tradition (surely Joseph told the story to young Jesus as he formed him in the ways of their faith); the early fathers of the Church were very fond of it as a means of explaining the sacrifice of Christ on the cross. The overall tone of the first reading, psalm, and second reading seems a little incongruous with the dazzling Gospel, until we remember that the Transfiguration was placed as the Gospel for this Sunday precisely to remind us of the glory that awaits those who live faithfully and obediently to the will of God. In the life of Jesus, it is a preview of the glory of his resurrection; for us it is a glimpse of the destiny of those who continue, as we heard in last week’s Gospel, to repent and believe in the Good News.

### HOW COULD GOD ASK ABRAHAM TO DO THAT?

Through the centuries, Christians and Jews alike have found the Binding of Isaac one of the most difficult passages in the Bible. Even though God intervenes to save Isaac, the whole episode strikes some readers as cruel. However, Abraham, the ultimate man of faith, raises no objection, offers no resistance as he simply goes about preparing for the trip and the sacrifice.

Today’s other readings might help us see that text differently. In Mark’s description of the Transfiguration, Jesus’ clothes become white and shining, and Moses and Elijah appear with him. Moses was the great liberator and lawgiver who led the Jews out of bondage in Egypt and into the wilderness, forming them into the people of Israel by giving them the Law he received from God. Elijah was among Israel’s greatest prophets, so close to God that, at the end of his life, he was taken up into heaven by a fiery chariot. Together, Moses and Elijah represent the Law and the Prophets, the ultimate authority for the Jews in the conduct of their daily lives.

### LOVE AND GENEROSITY

The Law, the Prophets—and Jesus. For Paul, Jesus is someone quite different from the other two. The reading from his letter to the Romans is short, but rich in meaning. When Paul declares that God “did not spare his own Son,” and when God praises Abraham “who did not withhold from me your own beloved son,” it is the same Greek word for “spare” and “withhold.” God’s voice at the Transfiguration identifies Jesus as his “beloved Son”—the same way God refers to Isaac as Abraham’s beloved son. Ultimately, God spares Isaac but not his own Son, whom he “handed over for us.” Even if we are disturbed that God tested Abraham like this, Paul says we should be overwhelmingly grateful that God did for us what, in the end, he did not require of Abraham. Jesus, God’s Son “handed over to us” in love and generosity, is already a sacrificial gift, signifying that God wants to give us “everything else along with him.”

## HISTORIA DE LA SALVACIÓN

La primera lectura de hoy continúa la “historia de la salvación”, relato que oímos a lo largo de la Cuaresma de este año. El relato de hoy era uno de los más queridos en la tradición judía (seguramente José se lo contó al joven Jesús cuando le enseñaba los caminos de la fe); a los primeros padres de la Iglesia les gustaba usarlo para explicar el sacrificio de Cristo en la cruz. El tono general de la primera lectura, del salmo y la segunda lectura me parece un poco fuera de lugar frente al Evangelio deslumbrante, hasta que recordamos que la Transfiguración se incluyó como el Evangelio de este domingo, precisamente para recordarnos la gloria que les espera a aquellos que son fieles y obedientes a la voluntad de Dios. En la vida de Jesús, es un anticipo de la gloria de su resurrección, para nosotros es una visión del destino de aquellos que continúan, como hemos escuchado en el Evangelio de la semana pasada, arrepintiéndose y creyendo en la Buena Nueva.

### ¿COMO DIOS PUDO PEDIRLE A ABRAHAM QUE HICIERA ESO?

A través de los siglos, tanto los cristianos como los judíos encuentran el vínculo de uno de los pasajes más difíciles de Isaac en la Biblia. Aún cuando Dios interviene para salvar, pareciera que toda esa historia es despiadada para algunos lectores. Sin embargo, Abraham, el último varón de fe por excelencia, no se opone, no ofrece resistencia mientras él simplemente se prepara para el viaje y el sacrificio.

Las otras lecturas de hoy podrían ayudarnos a ver esa historia de manera diferente. En la descripción que Marcos hace de la Transfiguración, la ropa de Jesús se vuelve de un blanco brillante, y Moisés y Elías aparecen con él. Moisés fue el gran libertador y legislador que sacó a los judíos de la esclavitud de Egipto y los llevó al desierto, formándolos en el pueblo de Israel al darles la Ley que recibió de Dios. Elías fue uno de los profetas mayores de Israel, tan cercano a Dios que al término de su vida fue llevado al cielo en un carro de fuego. Juntos, Moisés y Elías representan la Ley y los Profetas, la máxima autoridad para los judíos en el comportamiento de sus vidas diarias.

### AMOR Y GENEROSIDAD

La Ley, los Profetas y Jesús. Para Pablo, Jesús es alguien muy diferente de los otros dos. La lectura de su carta a los romanos es corta, pero con un significado muy abundante. Cuando Pablo declara que Dios “no perdonó a su propio Hijo”, y cuando Dios alaba a Abraham “quien no me negó a su propio hijo amado”, en griego las palabras “perdonar” y “negar” es una misma. La voz de Dios en la Transfiguración identifica a Jesús como “su Hijo amado”, de la misma manera que Dios se refiere a Isaac como el hijo amado de Abraham. En el fondo, Dios perdonó la vida de Isaac como el hijo amado de Abraham, a quien “entregó por nosotros”. Incluso si nos molesta que Dios haya puesto a prueba a Abraham de esta manera, Pablo dice que debemos estar agradecidos tremendamente de que Dios haya hecho por nosotros lo que, al final, no le exigió a Abraham. Jesús, el Hijo de Dios “entregado por nosotros” con amor y generosidad, es ya un regalo de sacrificio, lo que significa que Dios quiere darnos “todo lo demás junto con él”.

**“Angels Unawares” sculpture on display in Miami**

A traveling bronze, life-sized sculpture entitled “Angels Unawares” is now on display at Miami’s Bayfront Park, 301 Biscayne Blvd., until April 8.

Pope Francis unveiled the original sculpture, created by Canadian artist Timothy Schmalz, in St. Peter’s Square on Sept. 29, 2019, the 105th World Day of Migrants and Refugees.

Like the original, the replica weighs 3.5 tons and is 20-feet long. It features indigenous people, Jews fleeing Nazi Germany, Joseph, Mary and Jesus, people from war-torn countries, and Mother Frances Xavier Cabrini, patroness of immigrants, among many others. Above the 140 refugees crowded on the raft are the wings of an angel, a reference to the sculpture’s name and to the New Testament’s Hebrews 13:2: “Do not neglect hospitality, for through it some have unknowingly entertained angels unawares.”

**Escultura "Angels Unawares" en exhibición en Miami**

Una escultura itinerante de bronce de tamaño natural titulada "Angels Unawares" (Ángeles sin saberlo) se exhibe ahora en el Bayfront Park de Miami, 301 Biscayne Blvd., donde permanecerá hasta el 8 de abril.

El Papa Francisco dio a conocer la escultura original, creada por el artista canadiense Timothy Schmalz, en la Plaza de San Pedro el 29 de septiembre de 2019, el 105º Día Mundial de los Migrantes y Refugiados.

Al igual que el original, la réplica pesa 3,5 toneladas y mide 20 pies de largo. Cuenta con indígenas, judíos que huyen de la Alemania nazi, José, María y Jesús, personas de países devastados por la guerra y la madre Frances Xavier Cabrini, patrona de los inmigrantes, entre muchos otros. En el medio de los 140 refugiados apiñados en la balsa hay alas de ángel, una referencia al nombre de la escultura y a Hebreos 13: 2 del Nuevo Testamento: "Y no se olviden de practicar la hospitalidad, ya que por ella, algunos han hospedado ángeles sin saberlo".
